10/8/2014 - Solid Waste Committee Meeting

Meeting opened 5:35 P.M.

Attending: Therese, Joel, Merle, George, Pete

Reviewed materials received from Addison County Solid Waste District. A non-member must apply to join. A committee of their board members reviews the application and decides on approval or disapproval, setting terms and conditions, if any. Then the members vote. If approved, the Town would hold a vote to join the district.

The Town would have to provide a site for residents to drop off garbage and recycling, either to a vendor or a container for later hauling. Many other restrictions apply.

Joel and Merle discussed an Act 148 meeting they attended. One thing of interest was the process of capping a landfill. It would have to be covered by poly of x thickness, two layers at right angles to each other; a layer of x inches of sand; and then covered with two feet of clay. The best part – after ten to twenty years, if we wanted to put in solar panels, we could drill holes for the bases!

Much discussion around landfill profit/loss and ways of increasing tonnage. Also discussion around possible closing dates of 12/31/16, 12/31/21.

Tasks assigned.

Therese to call ACSWD to find out if a member resident can bring a bag/s of garbage directly to their site and to have Pam call R& L and Gauthier's to see what they would charge per bag for approximately 150-250 bags on Tuesday. This trash would not be buried in Bristol.

Pete to research the total cost of the landfill being open of Tuesdays.

Merle to contact Casella – to see if they are interested in leasing our landfill or bringing trash to it.
