- 1. Introduction of new PC member Robert Rooker
  - a. Robert was introduced to the PC

## 2. Approval of minutes from the November 21, 2017 meeting

- a. Sue made motion to accept October 17, 2017 minutes, Anna 2<sup>nd</sup>. So voted
- b. Sue made motion to accept November 21, 2017 minutes, Gary 2nd, So voted

## 3. Prioritize PC's future work.

- a. PC has created a list and will work to prioritize
- b. Town Plan and Addison County Regional Planning Commission Review (ACRPC)
  - i. In March 2017 the Voters of Bristol approved a modified Town Plan
    - 1. Plan only had minor changes from the 2012 version: Zoning maps.
  - ii. Normally ACRPC is notified and a review is requested, this did not happen.
  - iii. ACRPC notified the Town of the missing request and the process is in place to rectify this omission.
  - iv. Claire(ACRPC) noted, however, that the current plan needs to review the following topics:
    - 1. Flood Mitigation, Childcare, Economic Development, Municipal Storm Water, and Energy.
  - v. Gary mentioned that based on a recent ACRPC newsletter the new plan will also need to include a forestry plan and wildlife corridors.

## 4. Review draft of 'Site Plan Application Guidelines' document.

- a. Katie presented a first draft of Site Plan Review Guidelines.
  - i. Step by step review of process was reviewed.
  - ii. Discussion on concerns about current process
    - 1. Very complicated and confusing for general public
    - 2. Language needs to be simplified
  - iii. Discussed a checklist
    - 1. Current application has a list, but needs to be clearer that it is a checklist
  - iv. Suggestion that applicant be encouraged to have an informal review whit PC before formal hearing.
  - v. Concern that the current scale, 1" = 200', required for site map is too broad.
    - 1. Current Zoning Regulation call out this scale and would need to be modified.

  - i. 1<sup>st</sup> meeting was Dec 5<sup>th</sup>.
  - ii. Committee participated in an exercise of rating 22 different hazards.
  - iii. Top four hazards are
