1. Informal presentation of a proposed housing development by Kevin Harper of Stoney Hill Properties.

This project will be reviewed as a Planned Unit Development (PUD) and spans ROC and Village Mixed zones. Alan Huizenga of Green Mountain Engineering presented the proposed 11 unit development, 5 single family homes and 3 duplexes. The project would be accessed from the existing Firehouse Drive. An extension of Firehouse Drive will be constructed by the town to connect the loop drive through the development. All units are designed to be energy efficient with solar panels on the roofs. There is a proposed walking trail along the perimeter of the project. The applicant is hoping to bring the project to the board for a public hearing in the near future.
