The Selectboard has established an account on VT-ALERT, a Vermont state system for emergency notifications, that can be used to notify you in case of safety or health issues in the community. This is intended to provide timely information for such things as water line repairs, boil water notices, road closures, or issues with the sewer system, but may also be used for other emergency situations.
