INVITATION TO SIGN UP FOR BRISTOL VT-ALERT

Greetings:

We would like to inform you of a new program the Town of Bristol is developing as part of our commitment to provide and improve service for our citizens. The Selectboard has established an account on VT-ALERT, a Vermont state system for emergency notifications, that can be used to notify you in case of safety, health, or other emergency issues in the community. This is intended to provide timely information for such things as water line repairs, boil water notices, road closures, issues with the sewer system, or other emergency situations.

This is a voluntary program. To make the system work best for you, please provide contact information that will ensure the messages sent out through Bristol’s VT-ALERT will reach you in a timely and effective manner. Email and text messages (sent to mobile phones) are the easiest, but messages can go out through voice phone calls as well.
