II. Current business

Wrap up of Green-up Day Expo

- Good to have various groups present including the Conservation Commission, Historical Society and Bristol Trail Network.
- Bike tune-up was successful.
- The event is definitely worth doing again next year even though attendance was low this year partly due to weather and first-year issues.
- Begin planning for the Green-up event in February.
- Invite more groups to participate and think of ways to educate regarding the broader picture of sustainability. Consider a motivational speaker.
- Stephen suggested we think about running a Button-up workshop in October using storm window kits made in Maine. He'll report at the next meeting. It was felt that doing another "walk-through" event may not be productive until the following year.

Municipal Energy Efficiency Planning

- Ian obtained information regarding energy use for Howden Hall, Holley Hall, and the Library.
- Lawrence Memorial Library will be the focus of our first audit. Liston will schedule a day with Nancy. Stephen will have an interview with Nancy about the library. Stephen will look at past audits in town records and interview Ted Lylis re: Library.

- Richard distributed a town vehicle survey based on the Municipal Energy Survey and will begin to fill in the blanks.
