Subject: Update cost estimates for Town's share of Stoney Hill infrastructure

Hi Alan,

The Selectboard at their last meeting indicated they would like to complete the Town's obligations for the Stoney Hill infrastructure sooner rather than later in an effort to get ahead of ever-increasing prices. I met with Kevin last week and we affirmed our earlier thinking that it makes the most sense for that work to be done at the same time the other projects are under construction. He recommended we find a way to update the cost estimates and agree on a price that the Town would then either pay to Stoney Hill or deduct from the balance the remaining purchase price and call it a day.

Given your familiarity with all of the project details and access to pricing resources, would you be willing and available to update the cost estimates and come up with a current opinion of probable costs for the Town's share? One detail you may recall is that the Town agreed to pay the cost of overhead utilities and Stoney Hill would pay the difference for underground.

Please let me know if this is something you or your team can do and if there is any info you would need from me.
