Hi Ms. Capels,

I am the Project Manager on the subject project, and wanted to reach out to answer your questions below. At this time we do not have any detailed scheduling information. Bids were opened on the project on June 28th with Pike Industries as the apparent low bidder. We are currently working through the administrative requirements to execute a signed contract, and I would anticipate seeing that completed in the next two weeks or so. From that point, the contractor will be submitting many upfront documents, one of which is the detailed schedule which will show the anticipated start date for various activities, as well as the intended begin/end location for work sequencing.

In terms of traffic control, there will not be any detours for this project. Work will require lane reductions and alternating one way traffic, and is set to be completed during daytime hours.

Good Afternoon Valerie,

The Vermont Agency of Transportation (VTrans) has identified the need for a project to resurface VT Route 17 in the Towns of Bristol and Starksboro in the summer of 2019. Preliminary Plans are provided for your review and comment if desired.

The Bristol-Starksboro STP FPAV(19) project begins in Bristol on VT Route 17 at mile marker 0.600 at the intersection with VT Route 116 and extends easterly 3.763 miles ending in the Town of Starksboro at mile marker 2.050. The project consists of coarse-milling, resurfacing with a leveling course, guardrail improvements, pavement markings and other highway related items. Please note that centerline rumble strips are proposed at select locations within the limits of the project.
