Incident Action Plans (IAPs) are a way to expand your Local Emergency Management Plan with more comprehensive incident annexes **without** spending a lot of time on unknowable situation-dependent details.

This hands-on workshop will begin with an overview of the municipal incident action planning process and introduction to simple, concise formats for developing and recording municipal IAPs. These are efficient, typically one page, tools for developing an operational framework for specific hazards such as a flood, ice storm, pandemic, HAZMAT spill, train derailment, etc.

The presentation will be followed by time to complete your own IAP with one-on-one assistance. Come prepared with your top priorities to plan for. Need some ideas? Check you Local Hazard Mitigation Plan!
