# Presentation Display for Town Conference Room

#### Date

February 14, 2020

#### Brief

The use of technology in meetings is ever increasing and the Town of Bristol's conference room space could benefit from a large screen TV setup for presentations from laptops, tablets and phones.

#### History

When the Holley Hall basement space was renovated, a pull down projection screen was installed for use with stand alone projector for presentations and meetings. Over the years this setup has been used sparingly, mostly due to the awkward position of the screen at the back of the room behind audience seating, and the time and setup involved with obtaining a projection unit and positioning it for use. In meetings a projector is often balanced on a chair or pile of books, can be difficult to focus and fill the screen size, and requires low room lighting to view properly.

#### Proposal

To accommodate visual presentations for various meetings held in the conference room (Selectboard, Planning Commission, Energy Committee and Conservation Commission, etc.), I propose the purchase and installation of a Samsung Flat 58-Inch 4K UHD 7 Series Ultra HD Smart  $TV^1$  either on the west wall directly below the room's heat pump or the south wall behind the conference room table.

Comparable setups have been deployed in the Fire Department building, in both the training and conference rooms, and are used frequently and successfully for meetings and other gatherings at that location.

Both west and south wall locations provide excellent viewing for both audience members and meeting participants. The west wall is currently occupied by a metal shelving unit that could be easily moved. The south wall has pictures that can be repositioned or removed.

The LED screen will be mounted flush to the wall using a low profile wall mount bracket.

The Smart TV unit would accommodate laptop connection via an HDMI cable, and would also allow for wireless streaming via AirPlay to view content from an iPhone, iPad, or Mac laptop on the TV screen.
