## **CHANGE ORDER**

This Change Order made this \_\_\_\_ day of June 2020 by and between Addison County Regional Planning Commission, a governmental organization with an address of 14 Seminary Street, Middlebury, Vermont 05753 (hereinafter "ACRPC") and the Town of Bristol, a Vermont Municipality with a mailing address of P.O. Box 249 Bristol, Vermont 05443 (hereinafter "Bristol") amends the contract between the parties dated April 12, 2019 concerning consulting work ACRPC is performing on behalf of Bristol to develop Unified Development Regulations including subdivision bylaws (the "Contract").

The Contract shall be amended as follows:

- 1. The Completion date for the contract shall be amended to November 30, 2020, to allow ACRPC to provide support up through the time when the Town of Bristol will vote on the proposed Unified Development Regulations.
- 2. The amount of the Contract shall be increased by up to an additional EIGHT THOUSAND Dollars so that the total amount billed for the project shall not exceed THIRTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS.
- 3. ACRPC shall provide Bristol with a final draft Unified Development Regulation, modified to include Subdivision Regulations and shall support the Planning Commission and Selectboard's public hearing process revising the regulations as necessary until they are deemed ready for a public vote in November 2020.

This Change Order shall be effective back to December 1, 2019, construed under the laws of the State of Vermont and shall modify only that portion of the Contract addressed above upon its execution by both parties. All other portions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.
