

IMPORTANT NOVEMBER 2020 **GENERAL** ELECTION INFORMATION FOR BRISTOL VOTERS:

1. The Secretary of State's office mailed out Absentee Ballots to all active registered voters in Bristol on September 25, 2020. If you have not received a ballot by October 7, 2020 please call the Town Clerk's office at 802.453.2410 x5 or email clerk@bristolvt.org.
2. Absentee ballots can be returned in one of 4 ways prior to Election Day:
 - a. Mail to the Bristol Town Clerk using the prepaid return envelope;
 - b. Deposit in the large Drop Box at the entrance of the Town Office at 1 South Street at any time;
 - c. Hand-deliver to the Town Office during the new open hours of Monday and Wednesday mornings from 8:00 am to 12:00 noon; or
 - d. Bring it to the polling place in person at Holley Hall on November 3, 2020 between the hours of 7 am and 7 pm.
3. Use a black pen or pencil to fill in the ovals. Please do not use any other colored pens.
4. Place your ballot in the Certificate Envelope and be sure to fill out the front of the Certificate Envelope and sign it. The number one reason ballots are not counted is because the voter forgets to sign the envelope.
5. If you are unsure if you are registered to vote or want to check if your mailing address is correct then please visit "my voter page" at <https://mvp.vermont.gov/>. This site allows you to submit changes and register to vote.
6. Due to COVID-19 we highly recommend that you vote absentee rather than in person on November 3, 2020. If you wish to vote in person on Election Day please wear a mask and bring your absentee ballot with you to cast your vote. In person voting will be from 7 am to 7 pm on November 3, 2020 at Holley Hall.
