DATE: Thursday, 10/1/20 **PROJECT TYPE**: Roadway

LOCATION: Beginning on VT Route 116 in Bristol near the intersection of Airport Road at mile marker 6.006 then running north for 1.230 miles and ending at Class I/State Highway limit at mile marker 7.263 in Bristol.

Planned Construction Activities:

Crews will be painting any remaining long lines tonight beginning at approximately 6:00 PM.

On Sunday, 10/4 crews will begin painting roadway markings and symbols. This will include painting the lines for the parking stalls. Painting of side roads and symbols will take 2-3 nights to complete, and work is scheduled to begin at approximately 6:00 p.m. each night. When the downtown/nightwork area is to be painted, parking will be temporarily restricted. Please observe any temporary 'No Parking' signs. Vehicles left in temporary 'No Parking' areas may be subject to towing.

Day work tomorrow (Friday, 10/2) includes paving of side roads if the weather permits. Paving of driveway aprons may take place as well.

Driveway aprons and miscellaneous project clean up will take place all week next week during day time work hours.

Please note that paving, line striping, and roadway marking operations are weather-dependent. Inclement weather and unfavorable surface conditions can alter these schedules.

Traffic Impacts:

Expect one-way alternating traffic in the vicinity of paving and line striping operations. Delays should be expected and it is advised that extra time be added to travel plans.

As part of Governor Scott's "Work Smart, Stay Safe" order, all construction crews are currently subject to certain safety restrictions.

LOCATION: Beginning on VT Route 116 in Bristol near the intersection of Airport Road at mile marker 6.006 then running north for 1.230 miles and ending at Class I/State Highway limit at mile marker 7.263 in Bristol.

Planned Construction Activities:

Crews are currently in the process of finishing the paving of driveway aprons throughout the project. This will continue until all drives are completed, likely midweek next week.

Any paved gutters that need another layer of asphalt will be paved by mid-week next week as well.

Please note that paving is weather-dependent. Inclement weather and unfavorable surface conditions can alter the paving schedule.

Once paving has been completed, crews will begin to work on backing up the shoulders throughout the project, which entails placing aggregate material along the side of the road to fill in any low shoulder areas.

Crews will also begin to finish up placing topsoil, seed and mulch in areas as needed, and will begin working on miscellaneous work items and details that remain to be completed prior to the project coming to a close.

Traffic Impacts:

Expect one-way alternating traffic in the vicinity of paving and shoulder operations. Minor delays should be expected.
