

Minor Edits to Bristol Town Plan Draft

Changes since 11/9 Selectboard open hearing

p133(in the Enhanced Energy Plan appendix):- added the word, “of”

(now: “converting vehicles to renewable fuels like biodiesel produced locally could help reinvest some **of** that money in the community.”)

p152 (in the Enhanced Energy Plan appendix): clarified dates

updated “All planting must be completed within four weeks of the date on which the solar project first feeds electricity onto the electric grid (the “in service date”), or in the case of new commercial development the completion of principal construction. A solar project with an in-service date falling during frozen ground conditions must complete all plantings by May 31 of the same year.”

to “All planting must be completed within four weeks of the date on which the solar project first feeds electricity into the electric grid (the “in-service date”), or in the case of new commercial development, the completion of principal construction. A solar project with an in-service date falling during frozen ground conditions (**December 15-April 1**) must complete all plantings by **the following** May 31.”

[Dec 15 to April 1 is consistent with state limitations on spreading manure on frozen ground]
