Please consider declining signing on the Lincoln letter to the MAUSD School board.

It is written with an excessive amount of sensationalism and is designed to rouse fear with baseless information.

There is no impact to Bristol with how the Lincoln school ends up being modified or even if it is closed.

There is detriment, however, to Bristol with its continued use as a traditional graded school.

The Lincoln school is the most expensive school to operate in the District at \$28,889 per student and Bristol is the least expensive at \$16,134 per student. So, Bristol is in effect subsidizing the Lincoln school.

This subsidy also detracts from having available budget to build on and improve programs for Bristol Elementary to improve students outcomes, particularly systems to help those struggling to get on track.
