Description of the Event or Display: *Raise \$\$\$ for Youth Lax Team. Carwash station on North edge of green out of travelled lane. Bake sale/lemonade tent set up between parking and fountain, playing music for fun. Players will haul buckets of water from spigot/hose. Players will stand near main traffic light w/ advertising signs.*

Requested area of the park for use:

*North edge of green - 4 parking spaces at the beginning of row. 10x10 spot for popup tent and access to water spigot, and electric for boombox. (possibly)*

- 2) Copy of the contents that will be on display
- 3) Arrangements for security and public safety (parking, crowds, sanitation, traffic etc.) Cost to be covered by applicant.

## Background:

Bristol Youth Lacrosse (grades 2-6 from Stowns + Vergennes) wishes to raise funds for uniforms and players' safety equipment (helmets, chest + shoulder pads, <sup>3</sup>mouthguards, etc.)

By hosting a carwash and bike sale on the town green, the players will be taking a very active part in the role of earning money for their team, while also spreading awareness of this fairly new sport. Introduced to the youth age group in 2018, Lacrosse is a fresh place for our community kids to engage in a program that eventually feeds into high school level play.

We hope this will be a team building event for the players who attend various schools, as well as provide service to the community.

## Arrangements for Security + Public Safety, etc:

(noting time 11am-4pm  
SUNDAY)

- If possible, we would set up one or two signs and CONES the night before event to reserve parking spaces.
- Minimum 2 adults will be designated as traffic flow guards. They will wear reflective/orange vests and facilitate cars entering Park Street, entering wash area, and crossing for pedestrians, and exiting.
- NO cars will block the travelled lanes on North or Park streets. One vehicle / time allowed in the wash area. Others will need to park elsewhere in town, or drive around and come back.
- Sanitation: - All participants will maintain current covid safe practices advised by the state.
  - Those serving food will sanitize hands before handling food / beverages / napkins and after handling money.
  - Trash / recycling / compost bins will be located @ Bikesale tent and will be removed, after a scan of the area, after event.

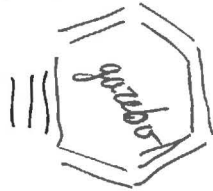
