Hello Valerie and Mike,

Thank you for your time yesterday. I've attached the two bids that were submitted. Both of them had a couple of minor issues but nothing major. We haven't conducted a thorough review yet but assuming that everything is in order, Kings Trucking & Excavating LLC was the low bidder at \$269,900 (\$269,905.70 after rounding adjustments). Below is a breakdown of the apparent low bidder based on the previously established proportions. The next step is to conduct another meeting with the landowners to determine if they're ready to move forward. Valerie, I'll leave that up to you.

25 West Street - 46% -> \$31,039.16

27 West Street - 36% -> \$24,291.51

29 West Street - 13% -> \$8,771.94

31 West Street - 5% -> \$3,373.82

Total by Sponsor -> \$67,476.43 (25% of \$269,905.70)
