Re: Kilbourn MHP WSID #VT00020612 – Public Water System Status

Dear Chris Ouellette:

The Drinking Water and Groundwater Protection Division (Division) has reviewed the Consecutive Public Water System Exemption Application for the Kilbourn Mobile Home Park public drinking water system received on August 16, 2021. The Kilbourn Mobile Home Park water system qualifies for an exemption from Federal and State drinking water regulations and is hereby exempt.

The Kilbourn Mobile Home Park water system receives its water from the Bristol Water Department drinking water system, WSID #VT0005002, and does not collect/store water or apply any additional treatment to water served to system users. The Division has determined that the current water quality monitoring plans for the Bristol Water Department water system reflect the quality of water provided to the Kilbourn Mobile Home Park users. Further modifications of the existing Bristol Water Department water quality sampling plans are not required at this time.

In order for Kilbourn Mobile Home Park to maintain the exempt status granted in this letter, releasing it from the requirement to submit water quality analysis results and distribute public notice, the Bristol Water Department water system is required to adhere to its approved water quality monitoring plans and issue all public notices, including annual Consumer Confidence Reports (CCR) to customers within the Kilbourn Mobile Home Park service area. Please keep in mind that while exempt from Federal and State drinking water regulations, the Kilbourn Mobile Home Park drinking water system is still a public water system, which allows the Division to take any reasonable steps necessary to address public health threats, should they exist.
