Hi Valeire,

I am working with a local boy scout (Willam Moran) who approached me about doing his Eagle project for the trail. He would like to build benches, which is something that the original group of BTN enthusiasts back in 2017 very much wanted to see, as places for “rest and reflection,” so I said absolutely. Attached is the design he’s using. He is proposing to place four benches: one on Basin Street trail, one at the Coffin Factory, one on the River Bend, and one on the Business Park loop.

The first three trail segments are, of course, on town land. Though the selectboard has given permission for the trail on those parcels, I wanted to be sure we get permission explicitly for these benches. Can you advise us of next steps?

He would welcome the opportunity to present his ideas to you and/or the selectboard as appropriate. As his “project beneficiary” I will accompany him and introduce him.
