Hi Valerie,

The fire department took delivery of a new Rapid Intervention Team (RIT) air unit this past Fall. This was a capital purchase approved by the SB. We have completed our compliance training on this new unit and have placed it in service. With that said I would like to proceed with the sale of the retired unit.

If you recall, last Spring the Monkton Fire Department purchased 15 self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) units from the Town when we retired them after receiving \$125,000 in AFG funds to replace them. This now retired RIT unit is designed to work with those SCBA units we sold to Monkton FD so it makes sense to offer Monkton the opportunity to purchase it.

I have generated a proposal and invoice (attached) for the sale of the RIT unit. I am respectfully requesting the Selectboard to authorize me to sell this unit to the Monkton Fire Department for \$500.

Could you please add this item to Monday's (12/13) agenda.
