During a flood event in 2019 the boulder on the up-river side of the platform shifted which caused damage to the two up-river support brackets. The repair will be completed in two phases.

<u>Phase 1:</u> A two-man crew will remove decking and level the platform with temporary legs going down to the riverbed. Once the platform is level; measurements will be taken to fabricate new support brackets.

Phase 2: A two-man crew will drill into the boulder and install new support brackets.
