

RE: 73 Maple Street Ability to Serve Confirmation

Dear Mr. Laroque:

We are in receipt of your request on behalf of your client Bristol Works regarding the planned construction of 3-bedroom residence on the newly-created lot at 73 Maple Street. This letter is to confirm the municipal water system's ability to provide an additional allocation of water of 420 gallons per day for this new residence.

The spring source is permitted at 568 gallons per minute and is sufficient to meet current average daily flows of approximately 260,000 gallons per day. The source water is pumped to a storage reservoir with a usable capacity of 632,000 gallons. We expect no adverse effect on pressure, fire flows, or storage as a result of the proposed additional allocation.
