Subject: RE: Repair of lamps on the twin bridges in Rocky Dale

This is the information I received back from our signal department in regards to the lamps:

“These are VTrans owned lights to my knowledge. It appears that when the bridge was designed maintaining these street lights was not considered. The one streetlight that is missing has been gone for 8-10 years if I had to guess and we will have to determine if direct replacements are still being manufactured. Our crew is planning on investigating the issues on the bridges tomorrow and we will work on a estimate for repairs given the need for lane closures and the servalift.

If we have power to the lamp that is out, we will do our best to replace the bulb but the pole may be 6 months plus even if we were able to locate one. Otherwise we may have to use a similar light fixture which may not match exactly.”
