Subject: Triangle Bike Loop Way-finding Signs Proposal

Dear Peter,

The Town of Bristol is pleased to express its support to the further development of the on-road bicycle route "Triangle Bike Loop" that would connect Bristol, Vergennes, and Middlebury—the region's largest towns and those with designated downtowns. Addison County presents tremendous opportunities for cyclists and that cyclists, in turn, support and enhance the economy of the region. We appreciate the City of Vergennes taking the lead on a Vermont Bicycle and Pedestrian Small-Scale Construction grant application to purchase way-finding signs for the route.

To support this initiative, the Town of Bristol commits to using the Town's resources to install and maintain the signs within our jurisdiction, and to report our costs associated with installation to the City of Vergennes to document match requirements.

We anticipate there will be two posts to install in our municipality. Each post will include one bike route sign and one directional arrow. The approximate locations for signs in our town are:

- 1 bicycle destination arrow (MUTCD D1-1c) Plank Rd. eastbound before North St.
- 1 left arrow (MUTCD M7-2) North St. northbound before Plank Rd.
