On November 16 of last year I reached out to you with a heads-up about ACRPC's intent to apply for funding to purchase way-finding signs for the Triangle Bike Loop. The grant program from which we sought funding opened recently, so this time I'm reaching back to secure a commitment from your Selectboard to support the project.

Support would mean committing your highway department to installing and maintaining the signs, and committing to document and share labor and equipment costs associated with those activities. We will need the documentation of labor and equipment costs for the match for the grant.

I have attached a draft letter of support for your consideration. Please edit to your liking, add to your municipality's letterhead, and send back to me if your town is willing to participate. I would be happy to meet with Select Boards or town staff if there are any questions.

One change is that we have learned ACRPC is not eligible to apply for the grant, but the City of Vergennes has agreed to step in and fill that role. ACRPC will be taking the lead on preparing the application.
