Time line of incidents of animal problem of dogs belonging to Vicki and Greg West, 239 Birch Ledge Bristol VT;

03/24/2022 Report of dogs being aggressive. Spoke to Vicki, she will complete licensing of dogs. She will address concerns about dogs at large. Explained to Vicki further occurrences would be brought to attention of the selectboard, they could impose conditions to contain dogs.

03/29/2022 Report of dogs following complainant to their driveway, barking and growling the previous night.

04/21/2022 Report of dogs loose again, Vicki called to report dog she retrieved the animals, they ran out when someone opened the door.

04/26/2022 Report of dogs loose. Dogs retrieved prior to arrival.

06/11/2022 Report of one of the dogs loose, was shot by neighbor. Vicki advised she would provide information about injuries. Tried calling back, no answer, goes to voicemail, unable to leave message voice message box full.

06/27/2022 Report of dogs loose. Attempted call to Vicki, no answer, could not leave voice message.

Request the selectboard instruct Wests' construct appropriate detention device to assure dogs are not able to run at large, authorization to seize dogs running at large, transport to Humane Society in Middlebury.

With implementation of new database system and ongoing learning process, there may be more reports of incidents. Above is a summary to establish an ongoing issue/concern related to dogs.
