I, Rachael Burmanig, (DOB) 8/4/89, make the following sworn written statement to the Bristol Police on my own free will and accord without any promises or threats made to me with the knowledge that it may be used as evidence in a court of law.

RNB

Last week my 10 yr old started riding the bus home to our new house. We have a shared driveway and the neighbors have lots of dogs. He has to walk up the driveway past all of these dogs. The first time he walked up three dogs circled him and were growling. He ended up walking through the wood and when he got to our house he was really upset and there was one dog still following him and growling. He told me then about the three dogs circling him and walking through the woods to get away. I called the town who got me on the line with Bristol PD. The next day I picked him up from school. Tuesday night after wrestling practice at 8pm we came home and one of the dogs came racing out of our backyard and ran in front of my truck. It was dark and this dog growled a lot and we didn't get out of the truck right away. (I have a 16 month old child). All week these dogs have been on my property (everyday) growling and we all don't feel comfortable going outside alone or especially in the dark. They have gotten in our trash repeatedly and circled my ten yr old twice as a pack. I have been getting out of work early every day just so I can make sure nothing happens to my kid on his way home.
