

TOWN OF BRISTOL VERMONT
Ordinance Regulating Speed in School Zone
Hardscrabble Road

Article 1 Authority: We, the Select Board of the Town of Bristol, Vermont, pursuant to VSA 24, Chapter 59, Section 1971-1973, hereby make and enact the following ordinance as to speed on Hardscrabble Road from the intersection of Monkton Road 800' West to 100' West of Hemlock Drive (0.3 miles).

Article 2 Purpose: The purpose of this ordinance is to promote public safety.

Article 3 Severability: If any portion of this ordinance is held unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected.

Article 4 Ordinance: Effective November 17th, 2014 the speed limit on Hardscrabble Road in Bristol from the intersection of Monkton Road 800' West to 100' West of Hemlock Drive (0.3 miles) shall be 25 MPH in both directions and posted at that speed, when school is in session.



Article 5 Penalties:

- a. This is a civil ordinance which shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions in 24 V.S.A. §§ 1974a and 1977 et seq.
- b. The penalty for violation of any of the above speed limits shall be that set by the Schedule of Fines established by the State of Vermont.


Article 6 Enforcement Officials: Issuing officials shall include all law enforcement officials.


Article 7 Effective Date: This amendment shall become effective on January 1, 2016, after its adoption by the Bristol Selectboard. If a petition is filed under 24 V.S.A. § 1973, the taking effect of this ordinance shall be governed by that statute.


Notice of Ordinance Adoption and Permissive Referendum
Ordinance Regulating Speed in School Zone
Hardscrabble Road

Attached is a copy of the Ordinance Regulating Speed in School Zone on Hardscrabble Road, Amended by the Bristol Select Board on November 2, 2015. This ordinance will take effect on January 1, 2016 unless a petition signed by at least five percent of the voters of Bristol is filed with the Town Clerk by December 2, 2015, asking for a vote to disapprove the ordinance. If a petition is received, the Bristol Selectboard will warn a special meeting and the voters may vote on that question.

HARDSCRABBLE ROAD

Article 1 Authority: We, the Select Board of the Town of Bristol, Vermont, pursuant to VSA 24, Chapter 59, Section 1971-1973, hereby make and enact the following ordinance as to speed on Hardscrabble Road from the intersection of Monkton Road 800' West to 100' West of Hemlock Drive (0.3 miles).
