Hi Valerie,

We will be starting the run and the walk at the Northeast corner of the park. The route would then be north on North Street, left on Church, right on Maple, right on Pleasant, left on Taylor, right on Elm, left on North, left on Pine, left on Liberty, left on Pleasant, left on Mountain, left on North back to the Northeast corner of the park. 3.1 miles. Our plan is to have people at each turn and traffic control on North at both crossings which I am happy to work with BPD with. The 5K Run will start at 8:15 and the 5K Walk will begin immediately following. I am imagining the whole event will be back at the Park by 9:30 or so. The course is designed to be scenic with as few busy streets involved as possible.

We will need an additional insured request for The Cystic Fibrosis Foundation from the Town. I understand the meeting is on the 14th and I am hoping that we will be approved and can get that request out to the Foundation on the 15th if at all possible so that we can get the documentation back to you before the event.

I realize this is late notice. It has been a tough emotional transition for me to actually say The Stampede as we knew it was officially over. But I do feel that this Walk/Run event will put us into the future with the continued support of the Town of Bristol and the 5 Town area.

Please let me know if you have any other questions and if you are forseeing any roadblocks in this request.

Dear Bristol Selectboard,

Our first Walk a thon and 5 K run for The Stampede 2.0 is happening on Sunday, October 2, 2022 right here in Bristol. We are excited to continue with the new and different fundraising opportunities that we are launching. The Walk a thon was our very first event when The Stampede was conceived so it seems appropriate to have it happening on its own this first year post the Stampede lawn sale that has been put in the history books after a tremendous 30 year run, raising just under \$2.4 M.

We are hoping to register both walkers and runners on the Park with the Park being the beginning and end for both. I apologize for the short notice, but I'm hoping that you will grant permission to do both events as you have in the past. The run will start at 8:30 am and the walk will start immediately following. Troy Paradee will be part of the team for the event and has organized the July 4 5K for years so we will basically follow the layout that they have used.

I will need a letter requesting that the Town of Bristol be added to the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation's insurance as an additional insured for that day. Given the tight timeline I hope that I can get that right away to get it off to them for documentation.

Thank you all so much for all the support the town has shown The Stampede for the past 30 years. As we move forward with Stampede 2.0 we are thrilled to be sharing it with Bristol!!
