Hi Valerie,

I hope you enjoyed the weekend and left this until after Labor Day.

The Energy Committee has a request for the select board. Would you consider putting it on an upcoming meeting agenda?

Richard Butz has been looking into a Building Energy audit for the library that was recommended by Rose Wall of Efficiency VT after the free walk-thru earlier this year. Matt Sharpe and energy committee members have been connecting with Coco Mosely and the library board about specific energy saving steps. A few local contractors have scoped out projects and given estimates. Ideally, to have the work covered with H.518 funding or other sources, a professional audit by Building Energy would likely be the most reliable path. It would cost around \$600 Richard expects. Our question is, would the Town willing to pay for the audit? Building Energy is ready to move forward if the selectboard approves. The sooner the audit is done and final quotes from contractors are submitted the better for applying for funding we expect. Richard would be the most knowledgeable member to describe the request at a select board meeting.
