

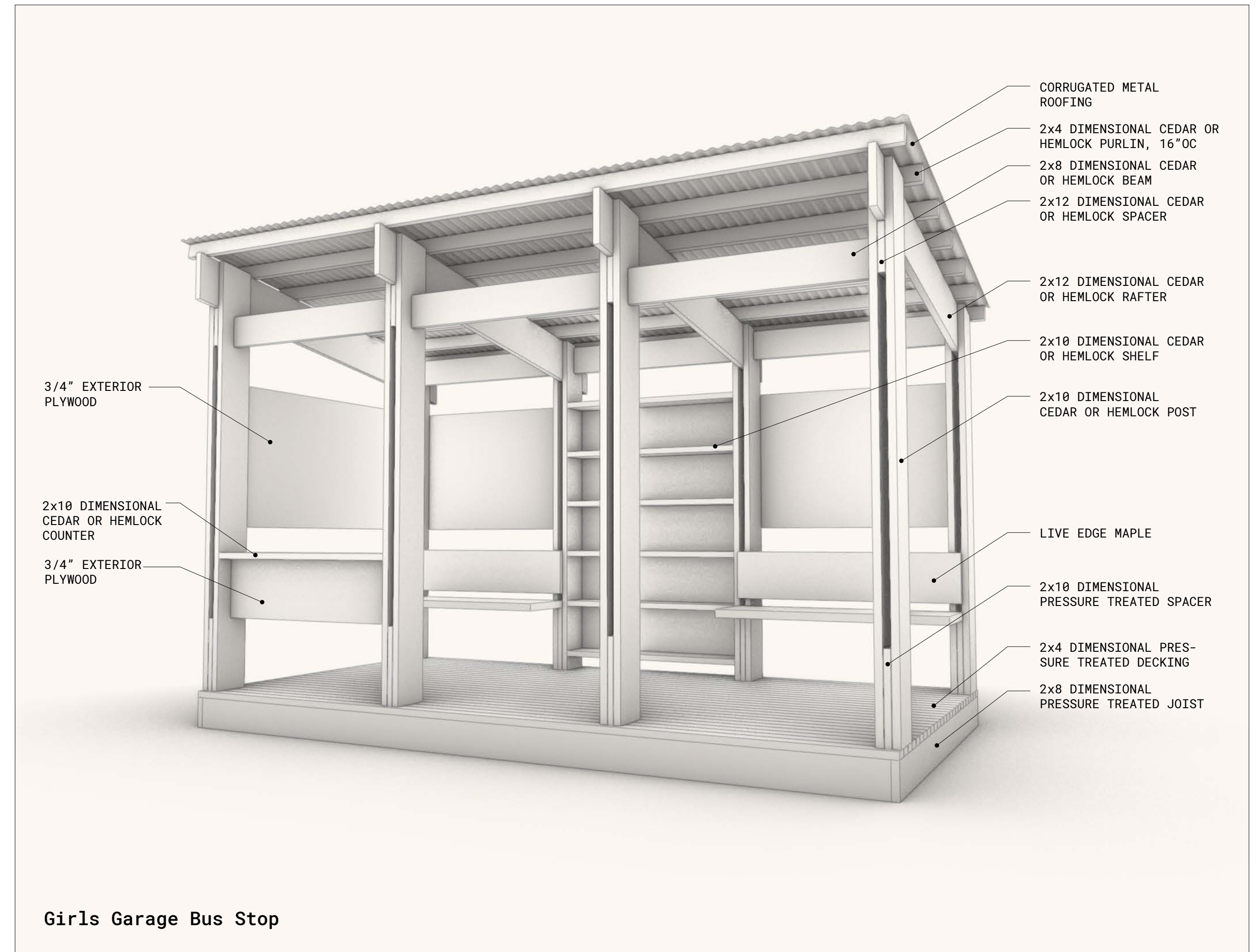
Public Bus Shelters in Bristol

Details

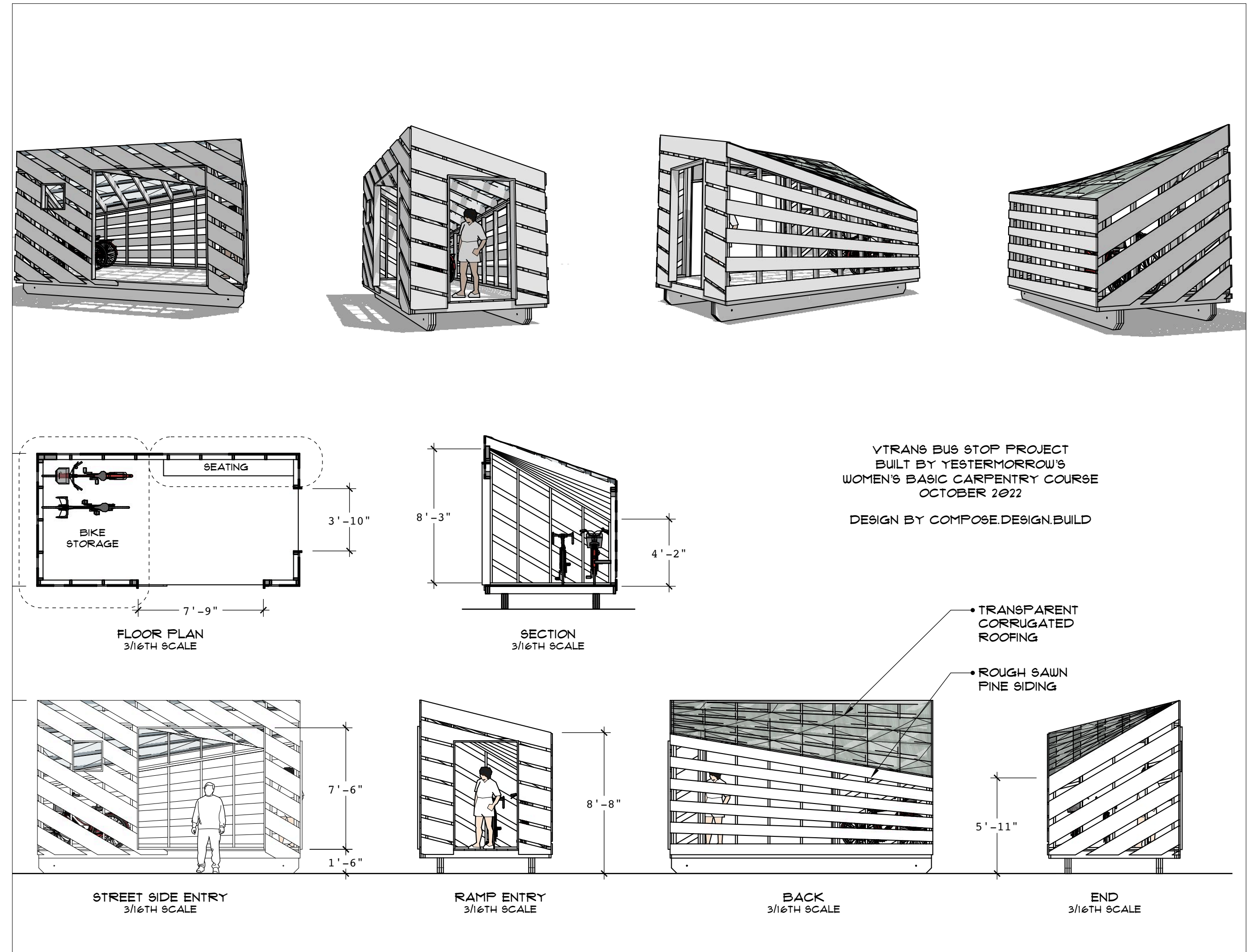
- This is a pilot program through the Vermont Agency of Transportation, AARP, and Yestermorrow Design/Build School.
- There are three pre-built shelters available.
- They will be awarded to community(ies) on a first come, first served basis.



Background

Logistics

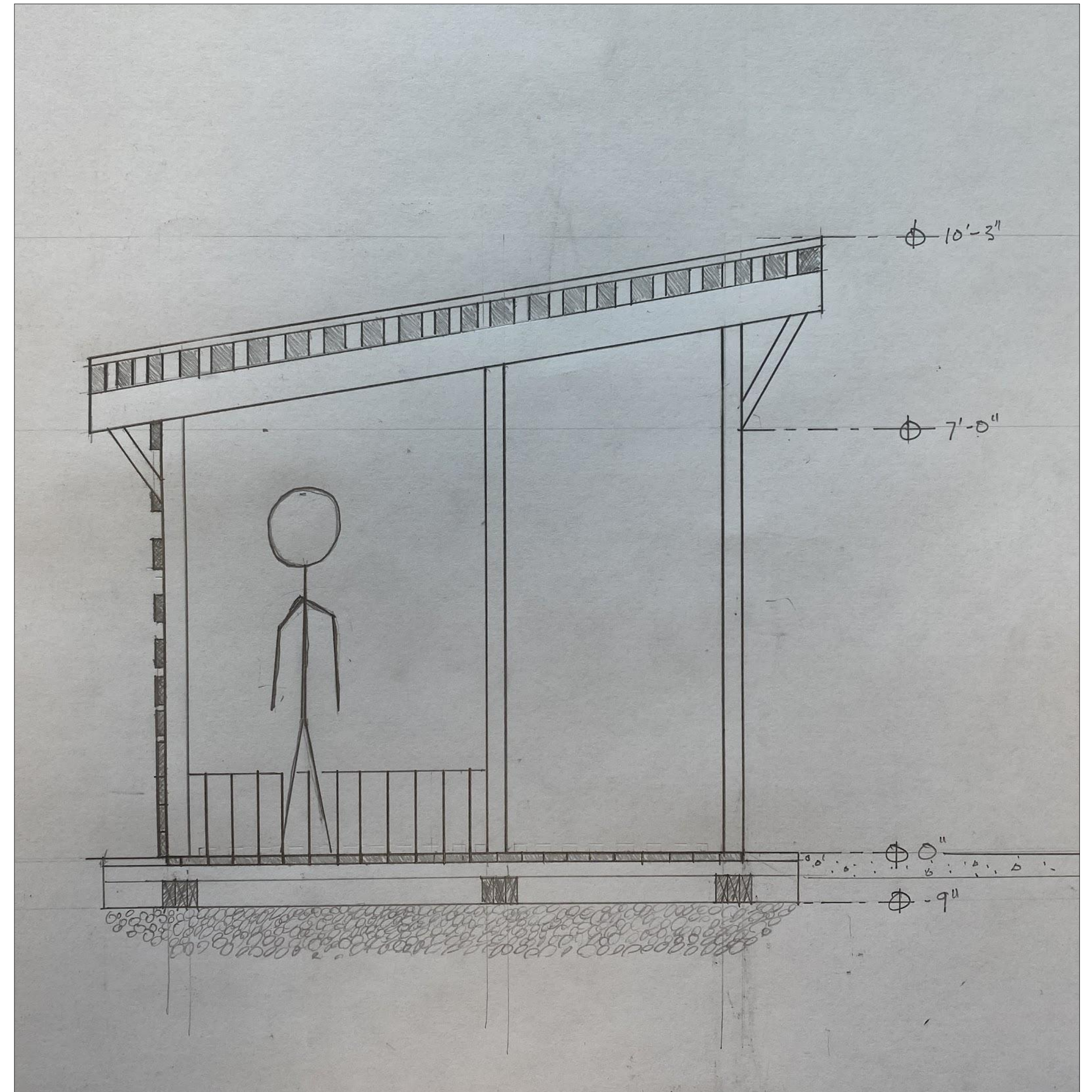
- The original funding source includes freight shipment from Yestermorrow campus to Bristol.
- TVT would own the structures.
- The Town would provide a prepped site and take care of snow removal and landscaping (just as for other public spaces).
- TVT would maintain the structure and liability associated with its use.
- Transit shelters must be wheelchair accessible by a sidewalk.

16' W x 8' 6" D x 10' 6" H
- “Bike” shelter
16' W x 8' 2" D x 10' 8" H

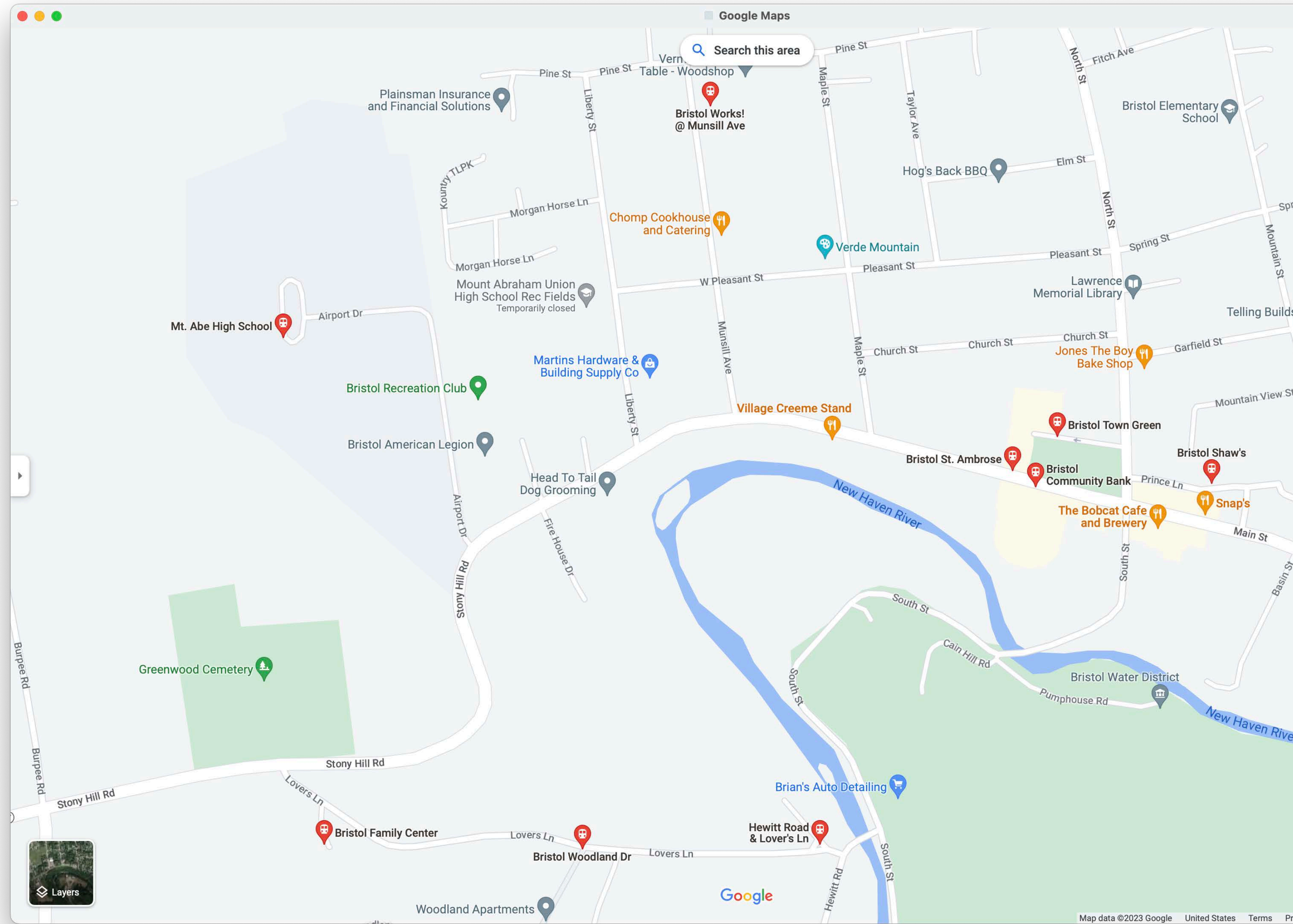

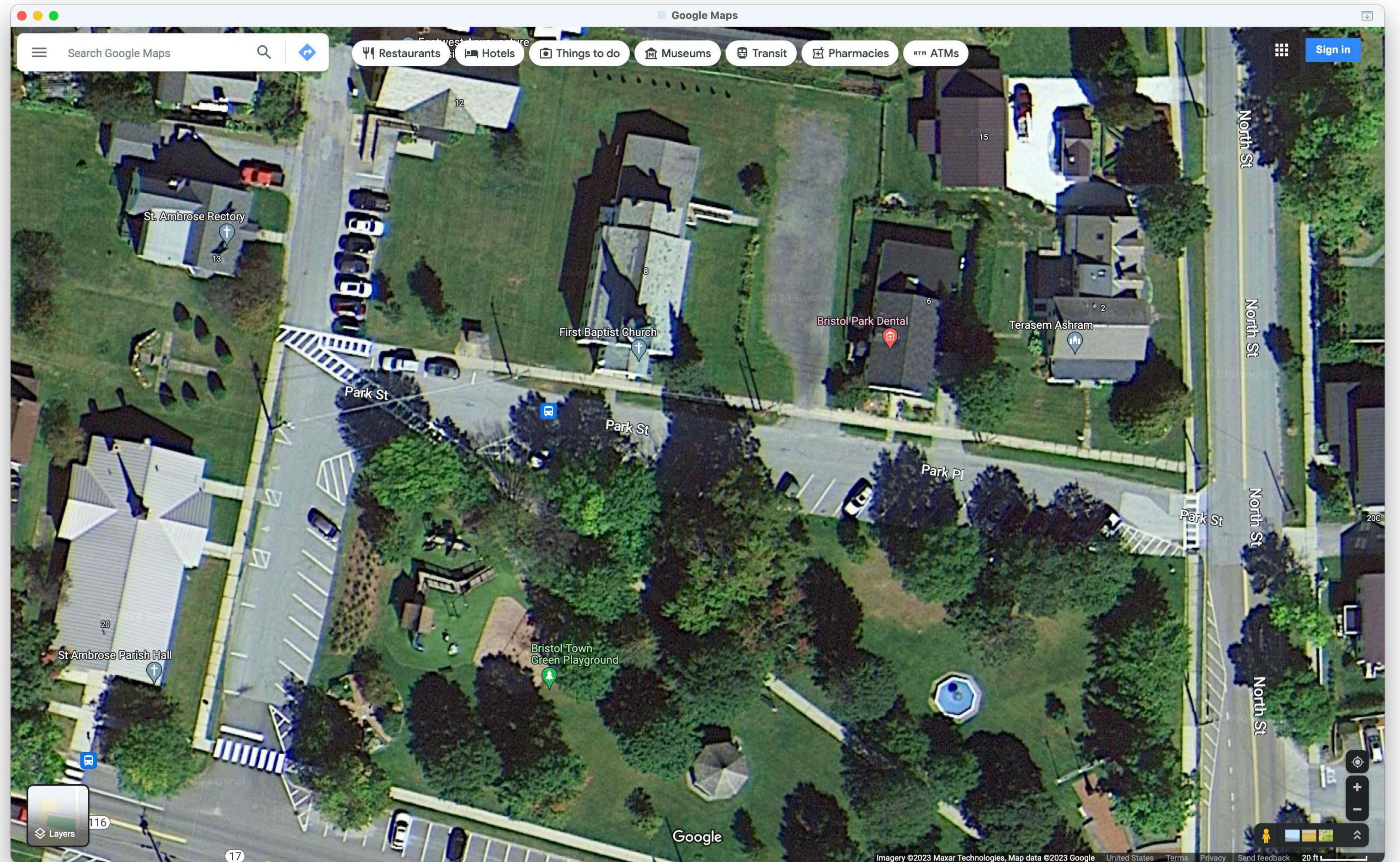

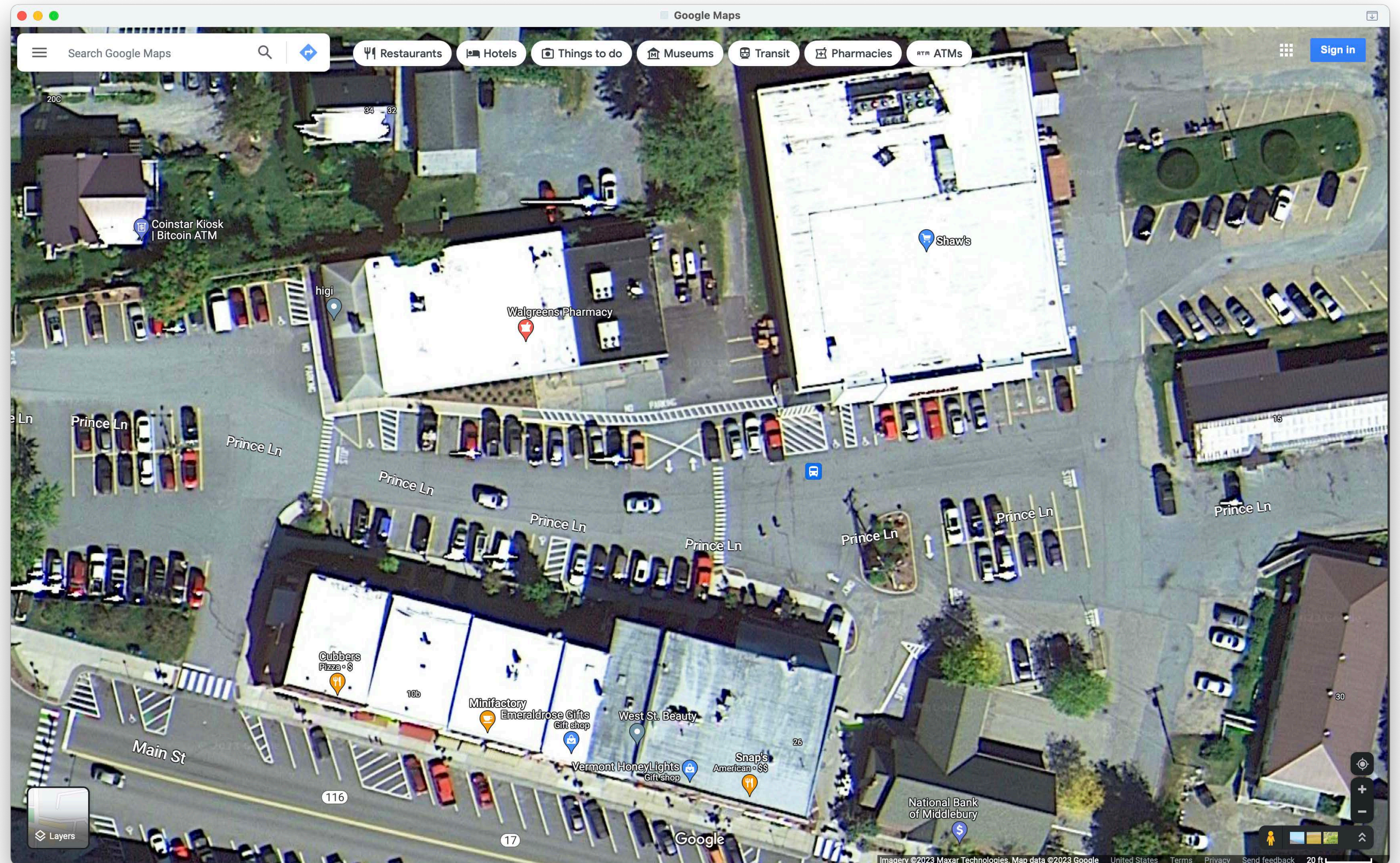

Bristol Town Green Park Street/Place



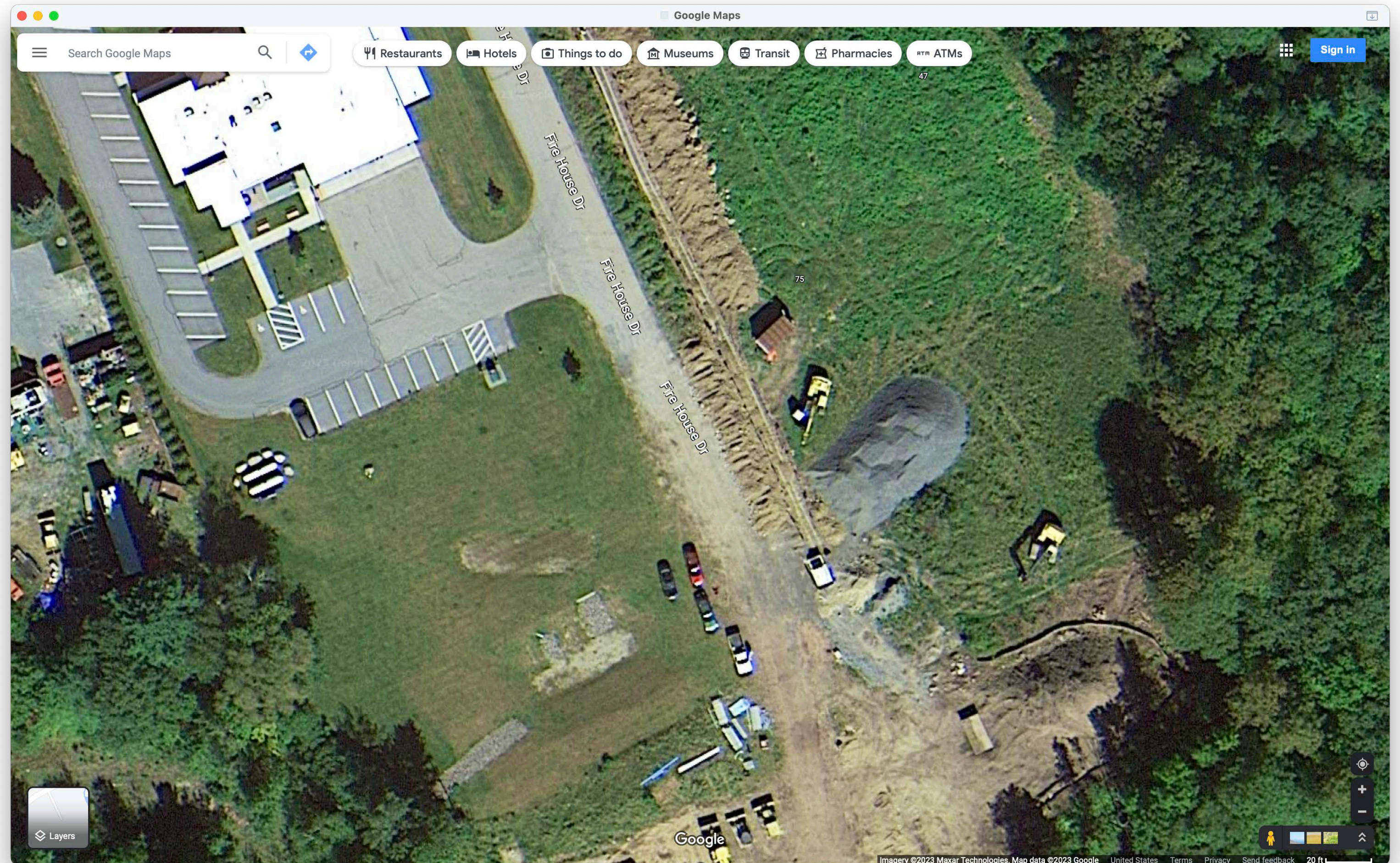


Bristol Shaw's Prince Lane



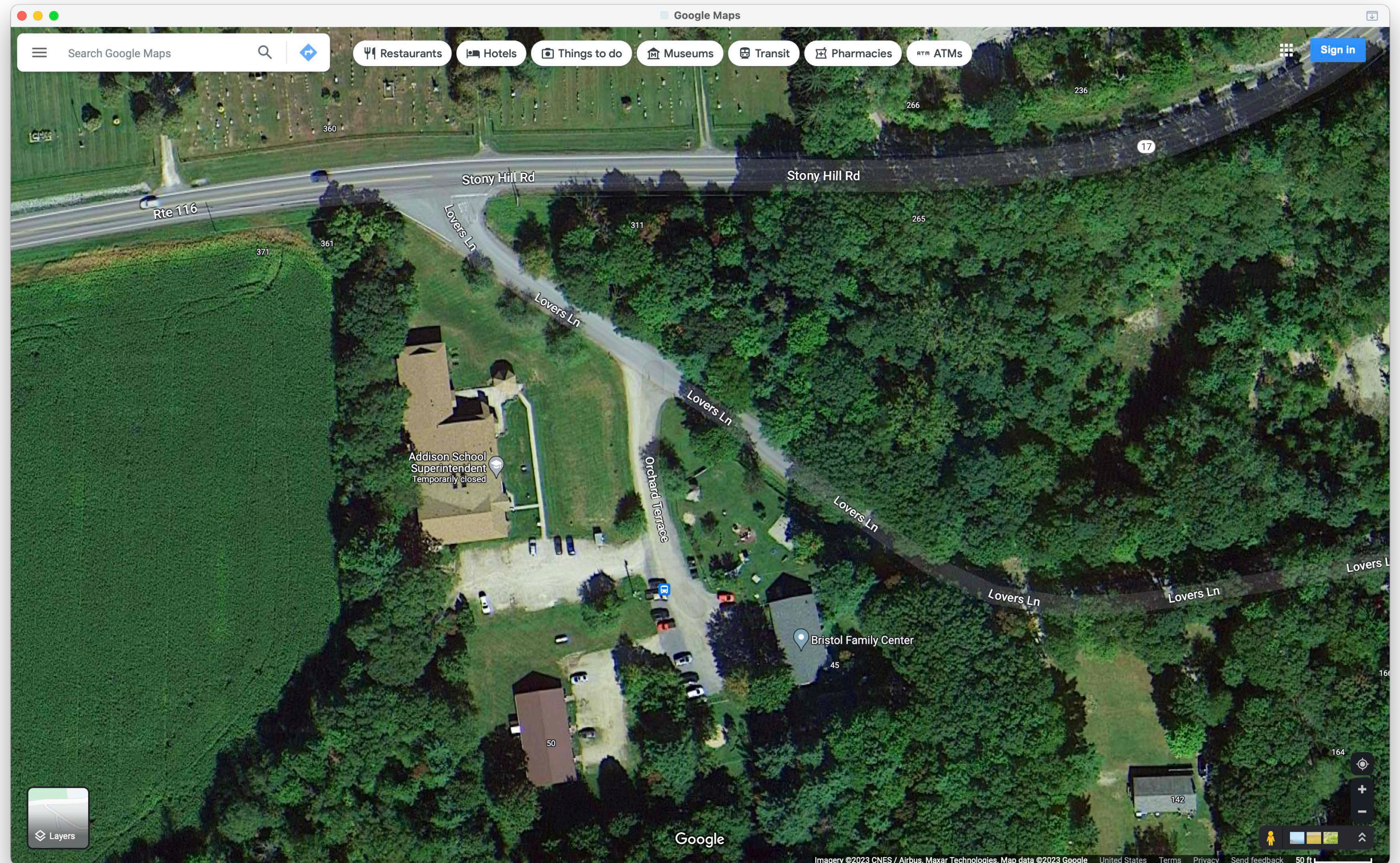


Firehouse Apts. Firehouse Drive

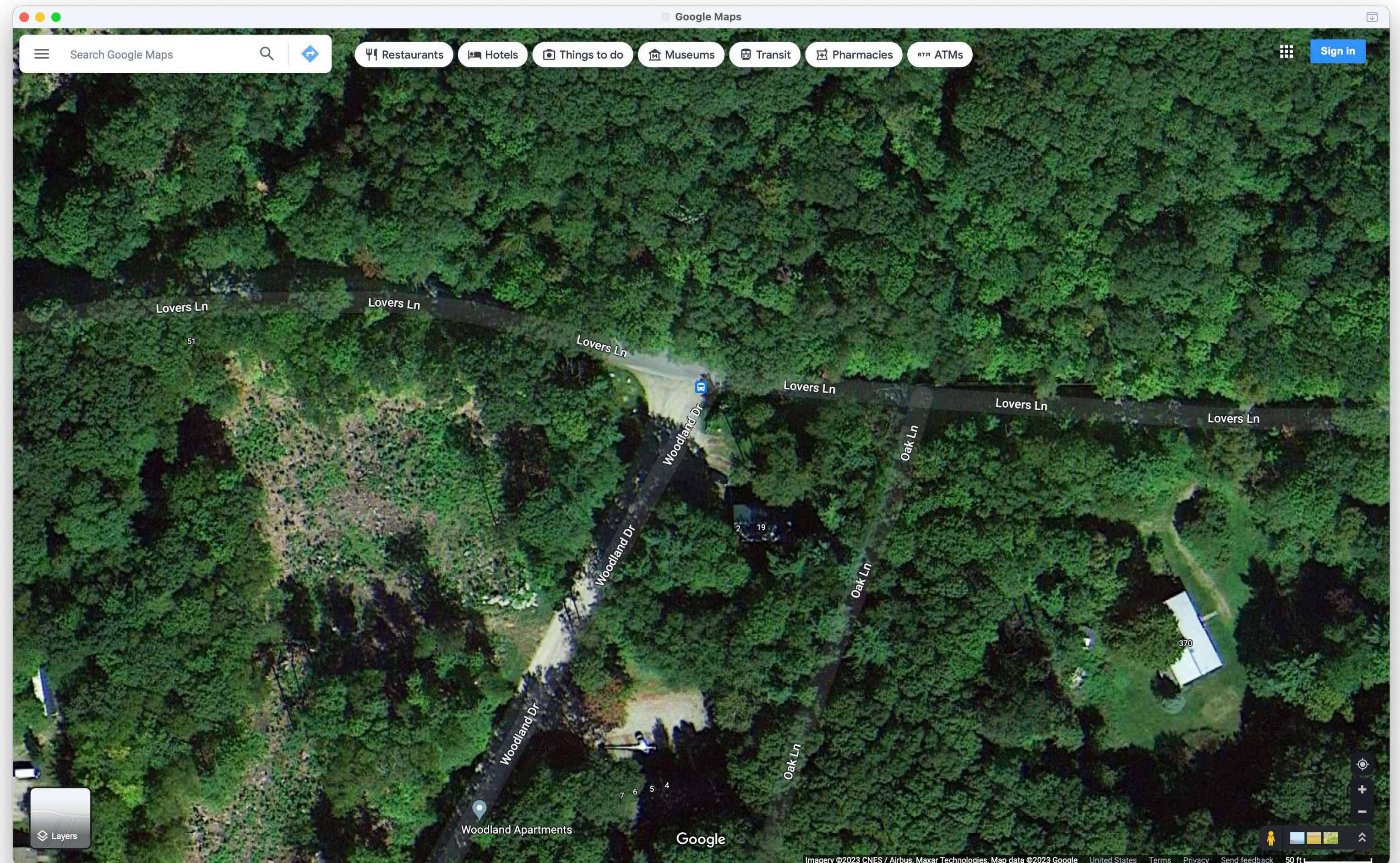




Bristol Family Center Lover's Lane
