

Clean Water Projects on Municipal Properties

Dear Planning Commissions and Conservation Commissions,

As the Clean Water Service Provider for Otter Creek Basin, ACRPC recently released an RFP for projects to reduce phosphorus in the basin. While the first round is now closed, there will certainly be more rounds and more funding to give out.

To help municipalities identify projects that could be eligible for this funding, I put together a map that identifies municipal properties that are on or near a water source, including priority/stressed waters.Currently this covers the Otter Creek and South Lake basins. Zooming into your municipality should show you all the relevant parcels and all water sources in the area, and there are other layers you can make visible for: VT Priority/Stressed Waters, Wetland Class, All Municipal Parcels, All Parcels, and Watershed Planning Basin boundaries.

We hope this will make it easier for municipalities to identify properties that may benefit from a clean water project and encourage applying for this funding to accomplish those goals. It is also worth noting that municipal properties not near water could still have eligible stormwater projects.

The RFP, application, and scoring rubric may be subject to future revisions in later rounds, but for now I've attached the current RFP and application as a refresher and to give you an idea of what we're looking for.
