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## RESOLUTION FOR AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDING ALLOCATIONS

**WHEREAS,** on March 11, 2021, the President of the United States signed into law the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to provide continued relief from the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

**WHEREAS,** ARPA created the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF) that provided direct funding to state, local, and Tribal governments across the country to support their response to and recovery from the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Bristol has accepted an allocation of SLFRF in the amount of \$1,148,473.80, paid in two tranches in 2021 and 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, SLFRF provides needed fiscal relief for recipients that have experienced revenue loss due to the onset of the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, Treasury presumes that up to \$10 million in revenue has been lost due to the public health emergency and recipients are permitted to use that amount (not to exceed the award amount) to fund "government services."; and

**WHEREAS**, Recipients may elect a "standard allowance" of \$10 million to spend on government services through the period of performance; and

**WHEREAS**, All recipients may elect to use this standard allowance instead of calculating lost revenue using the formula provided by the U.S. Department of the Treasury, including those with total allocations of \$10 million or less; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Bristol has the need to fund government services while in the recovery phase of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS,** the Bristol Selectboard voted at its March 28, 2022 meeting to opt for the revenue replacement standard allowance for the entire amount; and

**WHEREAS,** the Bristol Selectboard authorized at its June 13, 2022 meeting the use of ARPA funds up to \$1,500 to support the ARPA Funding Advisory Committee's public outreach and other activities, of which \$843.61 was actually spent; and

**WHEREAS,** the Bristol Selectboard voted at its May 8, 2023 meeting to allocate \$1,000 of the ARPA principal balance to Bristol CORE's fundraising effort for the Farmers Market and Pocock Rocks events and earmark approximately \$65,000 for creation of a new Grant Writer staff position; and

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WHEREAS, the available principal balance of the ARPA funds is now \$1,081,639.19;

**NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED,** the Selectboard of the Town of Bristol, Vermont authorize the following allocation of ARPA funding to fund government services under the replacing lost public sector revenue spending category as follows:

- \$130,000 to Bristol Rescue Squad, Inc., toward a new ambulance and training;
- \$ 52,000 to Masons' Libanus Lodge #47 for installation of an elevator and appurtenances;
- \$200,000 to Willowell Foundation for Wren's Nest Pre-School and housing expansion;
- \$ 55,565 to Turning Point Center for programming support; and
- <u>\$ 2,500</u> to Open Door Clinic for delivery of medical services to underserved communities.
- \$440,065 TOTAL for this allocation.

**BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED,** that the available principal balance of the ARPA funds, not including any accrued interest, is now \$641,565.19.
