Bristol, VT Ad Hoc Tree Committee Selectboard Update 8/28/23

The Ad Hoc Tree Committee would like to request to enter into contract with Boro Hill Nursery to plant 30 trees to complete our 2023 Growing Urban Forests in the Face of Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) Grant.

At the December 5, 2022 Selectboard meeting the Town authorized the Ad Hoc Tree Committee to apply for a 2023 Caring for Canopy grant. Original grant application was for a \$5,000 Caring for Canopy grant to plant 30 trees which requires a 50% match. We were awarded a \$5,000 Growing Urban Forests in the Face of EAB grant which requires a 25% match, so we reduced the scope to 22 trees. We would still like to accomplish the original intent of planting 30 trees. It was our understanding at this meeting that the Town authorized the funding of up to \$4,500 in cash as match for this grant.

On April 15, 2023 we posted an application to Front Porch Forum and received 22 replies from homeowners that wanted a tree. We've inspected these sites and have determined that 17 are suitable for plantings. We are in the process of identifying an additional 13 street tree planting locations.

On July 11, 2023 we sent a planting bid for 30 trees to Boro Hill Nursery, Horsford Garden & Nursery, Greenhaven Garden & Nursery, and Cobble Creek Nursery.

Recommendation: The Ad Hoc Tree Committee officially recommends Boro Hill Nursery as the lowest most responsible bidder.

Request: Enter into contract with Boro Hill Nursery for \$8,630 for 30 trees to be purchased, planted, mulched, and staked. Authorize purchase of 30 Treegator watering bags for \$1,200. Will receive reimbursement of \$5,000 from the state grant and Town will match with \$4,830 in budget funds.

Alternative request: Enter into contract with Boro Hill Nursery for \$5,858 for 22 trees to be purchased, planted, mulched, and staked. Authorize purchase of 22 Treegator watering bags for

\$880. Will receive reimbursement of \$5,000 from the state grant and Town will match with \$1,738 in budget funds.

Current available balance in A. Johnson Bequest is \$4,502.69
