I am working on getting a map from Troy Paradee since the route is the same as the July 4th 5K. The race actually starts in the driveway of Mt. Abe in front of the bus barn. I asked Devin if we needed the insurance certificate and he didn't know but I should get it in an abundance of caution. Which I did. So both MAUSD and the Town have separate insurance certificates.. Also, Troy's race finishes in front of The Old School House and not actually on the Park if the park is the issue. Otherwise it's town sidewalks and possibly the street in certain places, that the participants will be using. In the past for the Stampede we got the certificates for both the town and the high school which was about parking and started the walk and run from there and the Rec Club.

Do you have a street map that I can use to mark out the route in case Troy doesn't have one?
