Construction Activity

- Work to address punch list items wrapping up.
- Topsoil, seed and mulch being spread on disturbed lawn areas.
- Crushed stone being spread to restore parking area.

Design / Construction Notes

- Placement of stone boulders on both sides of the concrete walkway complete upon arrival. Bank run gravel washed into voids to fill and to help lock stone together.
- More boulders added on the river side of the walkway to fill void and pack newly placed boulders in with existing large boulders as best as possible.
- Top of slope has been reshaped and topsoil placed to restore the area that was previously planted.
- Composite deck boards were placed to fill gap between the platform and concrete walkway.
- Galvanized posts were cut to length and filled with concrete. Cap will be placed on top of the posts. Threaded eye-bolts were placed through both posts.
- Installation of the split rail fence to be TBD, currently scheduled for April 1st or sooner, depending on weather conditions.
- Boulders that previously lined the edge of the parking lot will be repositioned based on the final location of the split rail fence.
- Memorial stone was reset and placed near the entrance of the gravel walkway and informational sign.

Compliance Notes

• No turbidity is leaving the site.

Schedule

• Site restoration and punch list work to be completed on Wednesday March 6th, except for the installation of the split rail fence and final placement of boulders at the edge of the parking area.
