Dear Mr. Ladue:

We are in receipt of your request for confirmation that the municipal water system has the ability to provide an additional 280 gallons per day of water based on a two-bedroom single family residence.

Please accept this letter as confirmation that this service can be provided. The spring source is permitted at 568 gallons per minute and is sufficient to meet current average daily flows of approximately 300,000 gallons per day. The source water is pumped to a storage reservoir with a usable capacity of 632,000 gallons. We expect no adverse effect on pressure, fire flows, or storage as a result of the proposed additional allocations.
