Dear Bristol Selectboard Members,

I am writing to ask if you would be able to take care of the storm damage debris at the Varney Cemetery on Hardscrabble Road. Since moving back to Bristol on Nov 1, 2021, I am often walking or biking on Hardscrabble Rd and, since the storm damage last winter, have hoped it would be cleared out of the cemetery.

Back in the late 1960's, a friend and I had the job of mowing the lawn and clipping around those gravestones for a couple of summers. During that time I developed a fondness for that site where many Bristol residents from decades ago were buried.

I realize that many of the stones have crumbled over time - and some have been broken due to tree branches and limbs falling on them. While I know the cemetery is being mowed and trimmed, it seems that some attention needs to be given to clean the storm debris; thus showing Bristol's respect for those deceased and pride in caring for the places they have been laid to rest.

I am willing to lend a hand with the clean-up but do not have the equipment necessary for hauling debris away. I can offer my ability to load brush and chunks of wood onto a trailer or truck.

Thank you for considering my request, I will await word on how I might be able to help should you decide to do the clean-up.
