Hi Energy Committee!

I just wanted to let you know that I have ‘officially’ heard from Zachary Casey, Director of Energy Innovation at Green Mountain Power that **Bristol was approved for the Level 3 DC fast-charging grant.**

I’m trying to get further information about this, and it’s proving difficult. I have made multiple calls to GMP and am waiting to hear back. Our ‘partners’ on the project, Norwich EV, also have very little info.

In terms of the Town’s involvement, there’s very little. The project is on private property, and Norwich EV will work with the property owner (Thomas Wells) for the installation. The Town will play a small role in compensating the property owner over the next few years using already approved ARPA funds.

I have no idea when the project might start, but it's still fantastic news for Bristol.
