 - b.i. What is our budget, realistically? It would depend on what we think we can get.
 - b.ii. Are we going for pizza or a snack? Pizza would be good. Ben to talk to Cubbers. Allison could make some snacks too. Let's see how much

engagement we get once we put the message out and give it some more thought.

- vi. BEC Logo Design
 - a. Dan sharing screen with the logo. Sally suggesting if we could make the mountains look like Bristol. Seems like it may not work as cleanly, Dan to adjust and play around with it.
 - b. Dan will redesign it a bit based on the view from the intersection of 116 and 17.
 - c. Sun ray theme with the light bulb is the concept.
 - d. Sally suggesting Kimballs might be able to do something to help design it. Dan will continue to work on the logo concept.
- vii. Update on EV Chargers
 - a. BEC looking at the plan view from Norwich.
 - b. Need to be aware of signage requirements and beautification along the walkway between Shaw's and Walgreens.
 - b.i. Bristol CORE could do a mural contest for beautification
 - b.ii. Could Bristol Co-Housing be involved in the beautification?

viii. Update on MERP

- a. VIA provided a proposal and David and Allison provided some feedback on it.
- b. The proposal is phased. 5 phases: phase 1 is design phase, scheduled to happen in June. Phases go through March of 2026 which is when construction at Holly Hall can begin, after coordiantion with Meredith in the Rec Department.
- c. Proposal is on Basecamp, which Allison and David have access to.
- d. Architect is Bristol resident, Nick Wood. Has worked with VIA for 6 years, will be the lead with Asher as the overseer/principle in charge. Another designer will be assisting Nick. Engineering Ventures will do the structural design. D&K will do the electrical and mechanical system design. Some concern with using D&K after they gave some interesting numbers in the report phase from 2024.
- e. Pre-designing and planning happening in June (kick-oiff meeting, etc). Next phase is schematic design and pricing. Phase 3 is design development (Aug-Oct), bid Nov-Jan, construction March through end of fall 2026.
- f. Sounds like there's good momentum to move forward with this project. Concern still exists with finding a qualified contractor who is available.
- g. Proposal covers MERP at Holly Hall and the separate Library grant.
- h. Allison to send out proposal.
- i. Ian to present the proposal at the June 2 selectboard meeting. Ben to attend.

- ix. Addison County Energy Fair
 - a. Sounds like a yes. What's the ultimate ask? Rotate the hosting to Bristol in the future? We should be aware that could be a possibility.
 - b. ACRPC does a lot of the heavy lifting but we will stay involved and put our weight behind it.
 - c. Ben can respond to Jolyon in the affirmative and see what they need from us.
 - d. Efficiency VT sent Richard some materials so we have plenty of literature that we can share and use.
