- I. 7:03 PM: Review/approval of the February 22, 2024 meeting minutes - APPROVED
- II. Public Forum – Susan Grasso (Local Motion), Natalie (no last name given)
 - a. Susan: Local motion is running a winter webinar, spreading for awareness, provided link to check out:

- III. Human-Powered Parade
 - a. CD: The parade is back! Rec department has involved. Date = May 18th. Route around village police district, typically meets at The Hub. We have supported in the past in a variety of ways: Booth / Mechanical assistance to help repair bikes. Request from Meredith to provide 1–2 volunteers to work at intersections: Liberty / Pine, Pine / Maple.
 - b. CD: Encouraging members to volunteer for this event. We would like a minimum of two members to contribute. Cris will follow up with another ask / more details (time of event).
 - c. DC: needs to check family's calendar, intends to help volunteer
 - d. TB: Intends to be there helping with bikes.
- IV. Open Board Seats
 - a. CD: Jessica Teets has joined the Select Board and is no longer able to be a member of BPAC. This creates two open board seats. Jessica has forwarded ~6 names for individuals who would be a good fit. We want to get these seats filled ASAP. Cris will forward names to group.
- V. Quarterly Initiatives
 - a. CD: In advance of next meeting, we would like group to weigh in on quarterly initiatives. Check the meeting notes for items. Desire to be able to vote on items in April meeting > get grant writing underway.
 - b. Susan: Community survey, invitation to renew survey initiative. Local Motion has new capabilities to geo-code locations for community members to feed surveys. Cris will review previous notes to get see where things were left off.
 - c. CD: Asked Susan if she has a link to bike parking list.
 - d. BC: Shared link to OneDrive with Susan to give access to our minutes / initiatives.
 - e. Susan: suggested we could ask the community where we would like bike parking through the survey.
- VI. Grants
 - a. BC: Mentioned Goosewing Timberworks is looking for pro-bono projects, could

there be a possibility to work with them on an initiative?

- b. CD: The structures there were at the Police station are not available. They are for bus stops. Cris wondered if we could work with Goosewing Timberworks to envision what a bike lock station could be?

- a. CD: Reached out to Valerie for a published plan for Pine Street and airport road, will follow up when we learn more, for us to weigh how this aligns previous BPAC Pine Street initiatives.
