  - a. AZ – Saying hello / introduction to the committee

  - a. Cris: shared deck containing overview of the different grants
  - b. Brigitta Lawrence: Suggested that the town explore adding a warming / cooling shelters needed for emergency weather situations. Was also curious how do we alert individuals to consider evacuating, especially mobile homes  
Jessica: The fire station is our area designated for that role, advised follow up with Ian Albinson, warnings have been mostly sent out through front porch forum, we currently don't have a mobile system to alert folks via mobile / texting  
Jim: This is not a prevue of this committee, bring this up to the town administrator
  - c. Ideas: (contained in the same presentation deck)  
Mountain Street survey to help curb excessive speeding  
Beacon crosswalks (North/Pleasant; Liberty/West Pleasant)  
Bike storage/bike racks  
Path to Rockydale from Bristol Village  
Continue sidewalk on North Street (out to / past Plank, to the Nursery)  
Lovers lane up to high school (up Stoney Hill) make more pedestrian friendly  
Lovers Lane to Hewitt to South as a route
  - d. Voting: Which ideas / grant pairings to move forward
  - e. Grant Idea #1: Mountain Street Survey – Aligned with AARP grant – YES
  - f. Grant Idea #2: North / Pleasant beacon crosswalk – aligned AARP VT Flagship or Demonstration Grant – YES
  - g. Grant Idea #3: Bike Storage / Bike Racks (work to identify 4-5 locations that would be a prime spot for a bike rack to live) – aligned with AARP Flagship Grant – YES
  - h. Grant Idea #4: Rockydale / Falls connection – AARP with – YES
  - i. Grant Idea #5: North Street pedestrian / cyclist safety, before aligning to grand first
