1. Citizen Comments/Concerns
 - a. None
2. Approve Agenda

4. Planning Commission Crossover - Enhanced Energy Plan Implementation Tasks
 - a. Ben to reach out to Walk-Bike Council of Addison County. Probably need to find a new representative for Bristol.
 - b. Row 6 Window Dressers: Allison is going to serve as a measurer in Addison County and those folks will go to Shelburne for the build.
 - c. Ben to update Row 7 with info from AZ on self certification and FAQ sheet info.
 - d. Update row 18 same as first row.
 - e. Community outreach to FPF on motor idling law.
5. Holly Hall & Library MERP Update
 - a. Library: getting quotes for remediation inside. Working on outside stuff in the meantime. Pop up library location coming soon in the meantime.
 - b. Progress on Holly Hall on-going, on schedule as far as we know.
 - c. David walking us through the building science of the new interior walls and the interior mineral fiber/rock wool insulation.
 - d. Some mechanical equipment installation appears to be happening based on latest pictures from 9 June 2026.
 - e. Reviewing pictures of Holly Hall and Library.
6. Addison County Energy Navigators Funding Call
 - a. Deadline for signatures is January 15.
 - b. Need to get about 170 signatures of registered voters in Bristol (percentage-based). Food shelf has done this before and Allison can help.
 - i. This can be done at any point. Typically do it on Saturday morning at the dump or at the Mount Abe Craft Fair. Allison talked to Mike Roy and Steve Meyer (Exec Director) and asked for Bristol participation rate as a

selling point. Carl Engvall is contracted with CEAC to put together a list of Contractors who can do the work that Energy Navigators identifies. Carl is also going through the Energy Navigator training and Allison wants to do it this year too.

- c. Allison can write a rough draft of the petition and some back-story and a pitch. Also, how much will we ask the Town for? Look at past Town Report. \$1500 to start?
 - d. Targeting next month for draft.
7. EV Chargers - Level 2 & Level 3
- a. No update.
8. ToolShip
- a. Jeff D. thinks they can let us borrow the Brandon ToolShip for a Monday Farmer's Market.
 - b. Allison is on Farmer's Market committee so we should just tell them dates and they can help coordinate with social media. We can do FPF posting too to get interest going.
 - c. Considering a Monday in August, look at calendars and pick one. Think about Efficiency Vermont rebate info to have on that date too. Efficiency Vermont contact in Monkton go there too to share. Plan the date in the July meeting. Target August 10 or August 17.
9. Legislative & Community Updates
- a. REV Update on Net Metering. PUC issued an increase in the state-wide blended residential rate in-line with previous biennial updates (2.3 c/kWh) but noted that a new rulemaking process is still under consideration. PUC left it open to change later.
