Bartlett Falls

This location is synonymous with Bristol for many visitors but has never been formally included in the town planning or oversight. We think in 2028, we should begin the process of exploring what can be done at this site to improve recreation (safety, messaging, risk management) and conservation (bank erosion) and who can help us in this endeavor?

Memorial Park

It could be the veritable gem of the town, but years of neglect and the sheer size of the effort needed has been a barrier to reinvigorating this destination for locals and tourists.

Wildlife habitat connectivity

We hope that the 2028 plan can take our wildlife connectivity data into consideration. The current maps and information were from c.2000. We hope we can encourage in-filling development instead of encouraging sprawl.
