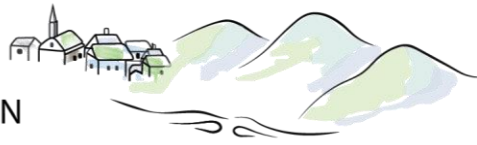
Projects will be funded through the Transportation Planning Initiative (TPI). ACRPC is preparing to submit its FY 2027 (Oct. 1, 2026 – September 30, 2027) Workplan and Budget. The TPI is designed to foster greater involvement in the transportation planning process by local citizens and officials. Each year, the ACRPC sets aside a portion of the annual TPI funding received to hire consultants to perform various transportation studies in the county on behalf of our member municipalities, a consortium of municipalities, or a regional organization. Grant awards are contingent on ACRPC receiving funding from VTrans.

- Infrastructure siting assessments

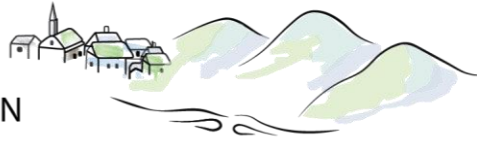
