Hi Tom

Hope you're having a great summer.

The Bristol Selectboard received a request from homeowners on Garfield Street in Bristol. The homeowners would like a convex mirror installed on the utility pole across from Garfield Street (on North Street – picture attached) to enable drivers on Garfield Street to see on-coming traffic from the south particular in the winter when the snow banks at Almost Home sometimes build up and block sight distance.

The Town Administrator has asked me to find out if this is feasible. First I know that GMP does not like items on their poles in case the poles need to be climbed. This pole is roadside and appears in the road right-of-way and it would probably be a rare occurrence to climb it. With that said would GMP allow a mirror on the pole and if so, could the Town public works department install it or would GMP have to install it on pole. I would imagine that it would be 8-10' off the ground. Also if GMP allows the mirror to be installed will the town need to provide proof of insurance? Any other information would be helpful as well.

Let me know if you have any questions. The next Selectboard meeting is Monday September 2. It would be great if I could have a response by Thursday, August 29, 2019 by noon so the response can go in the Selectboard package provided to the Board on Friday.
