Dear Ms. Capels,

This email serves as notification that the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Program is bypassing the Town of Bristol, Wastewater Treatment Upgrade Project improvement project that is on the SFY2020 Project Priority List. The basis for this determination is that a Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) for the project was not submitted by August 31, 2019 as required.

The Town of Bristol is encouraged to apply for the SFY2021 Project Priority List for construction funding during the 2020 construction cycle (7/1/2020 to 6/30/2021). We will begin soliciting for applications to that priority list this December.

We also urge Town of Bristol to take advantage of the CWSRF's generous planning loan terms and additional subsidy. This program includes loans for asset management, feasibility studies, preliminary engineering, and final design. At this time, planning loans are 0% interest and 0% administrative fee and no payments for 5 years. We also are offering additional subsidy, in the form of loan principal forgiveness, of 50% of planning costs up to \$100,000 per project. The additional subsidy is finite, and is provided on a first-come-first-served basis until it has been expended.
